- Refrain from engaging in gossip or negative conversations with others that would bring disruption and/or tension to the team and players. Refrain from negative comments on social media that may be construed or misconstrued in the proper context.
- Parents will not be permitted in or near the dugout before, during or after a game unless given special permission by the coach and if they hold up to date clearances.
- Do not question an umpire. Accept the umpire's decision as final. The only person that can question an umpire is a member of the coaching staff and they will do so in a mature manner.
- I agree to accept the coaches' decision regarding playing positions and amount of playing time.
